

Goldfinger Potentilla

potentilla fruticosa 'Goldfinger'

A deciduous shrub that reaches 3-4 feet in height and spread. Does well in average soil and is relatively fast growing. Locate in full sun.

Once established it survives on moderate watering which is only needed to supplement a lack of natural precipitation.

This shrub flowers in June and July with many small yellow blossoms, making a very eye-catching centerpiece to a garden.

After several years the plant may begin to look shabby. Trim the plant to within several inches of the ground in late fall and it will renew with evenly distributed growth the next spring.
