Russian Sage

Perovskia atripilcifolia

A drought tolerant, perennial shrub that produces attractive blue flowers in late-summer. Natural spring and summer rains are often enough for this plant.

Average soil with good drainage, and full sun.

Can grow up to three to five feet high and wide.

To produce a more compact plant with heavier flower production, prune in early spring to a height of about six inches when first growth appears near the base of previous year's stems.
