TREES Had a nice turnout for the "Tree Seminar" a few weeks ago. Learned many facts about mountain pine beetle and mistletoe, the two major varmints attacking our Ponderosa pines. The beetles are in their most active period right now so they could be making their way toward trees manifesting signs of distress or weakness. You can spray to protect your trees but we were told it's not all that effective. Best solution is to remove affected trees. Mistletoe is somewhat less of a worry but it can still eventually kill a tree and should be removed as much as possible. Got an article from one of the Woodmoor Tree Monitors talking about dying aspen trees. Gist of it is that aspens are dying because of drought. We've had a 3 to 5 year period with less precip than normal and the current rainfall is not enough to make them recover. They require lots of water.

DON'T FORGET THE ACC

APPROVAL. Your house has been constructed and you're enjoying the good life in King's Deer. Now you decide it's time to make a few improvements or changes to your home. Perhaps you want to expand your landscaping, add a fence, replace a driveway monument, add exterior lighting, plant a large tree, install some playground equipment, enlarge the parking area, add a bay window, or enlarge your deck. Wait! Projects that alter the exterior of your house, add or change exterior features on the property, or alter the landscaping must be approved by the ACC in advance. Failure to obtain such approval might result in a covenant violation notice and possibly require that you restore the property condition if the modification is unacceptable in King's Deer. Before financially committing yourself to a project, talk to the neighbors to be sure they are aware of what you have in mind...don't surprise them. This can eliminate potential conflicts and it helps improve cooperation. Then, identify all of the details of your proposal on an ACC Miscellaneous Projects Application form.

Kings Deer News 2790 N. Academy, Ste 312 Colo. Springs, CO 80917 Fully explain all changes that you propose. Photos of the existing conditions, annotated with the proposed changes are very helpful. Deliver the completed application to the KD Sales office. The ACC members want to approve the projects, but at the same time they are obligated to ensure that covenants are met. Please don't take the chance of proceeding with your project without ACC approval; it can result in a costly and stressful situation for all concerned. Include the ACC in your planning.
