Whether this was a criminal act or an accident is not clear; however in this case the dogs were restrained within a fenced area at the house when poisoned. This situation serves to reminder pet owners to be vigilant in controlling your pet—which this family was—and to carefully watch what might be in the area that your pet is allowed to roam freely.

Should be ready for business next week. It will be led by a great young man as Battalion Chief, Bryan Jack. Bryan is certified as Firefighter II, certified Wild-land Firefighter and is a Paramedic. He's already been recognized with the Meritorious Service Award for a rescue he performed at a serious fire. Bryan says they will have 3 teams of 2 paramedic/firefighters for each shift on duty 24/7.
